Among many changes, **Disney** installed six weather-resistant BAG END D18E-I double-18 subwoofer enclosures to help improve the quality and clarity of the sound, according to **Ken Petersen**, principal audio/video engineer for **Disney Imagineering**.

BAG END's weather-resistant speaker systems differ in a number of ways from standard models. The weather-resistant enclosures are coated both inside and out with a special high-tech material that seals the cabinets against moisture, the speaker cones are specially treated, electrical connections are weather-proofed and all the hardware is either stainless steel or aluminum to assure further resistance to corrosion. In addition, BAG END uses special mounting brackets that pitch enclosures at a 10 percent angle to shed moisture.

"We upgraded the entrance background music system using and four of our 12-foot line arrays and six D18 boxes from BAG END," said Ken Petersen, principal AV engineer at Disney Imagineering.
